Then using various tools he started forming the legs by removing the extra wood between what would become the legs. He started with coarse tools and then used successively finer tools to further refine the legs. Kent demonstrated how he holds the bowl while working on it. If you have seen Kent's work you know the detail he puts into his work. He did an excellent job with his demonstration.
